Mr. Davis:

Pursuant to our telephone conversation this morning, I am sending you the affidavits of Reno Reiley and Brenda Aguilar. The other individuals listed in your letter have not submitted affidavits.

As I mentioned, recent investigation has revealed additional allegations of misconduct. I am in the process of having supporting affidavits signed by additional witnesses, including Victor Pacheco, Jim Boeck, Debbie Landrum, and Eric Lehr. The new allegations against Mr. Collazo are:

- *That Collazo used racial or ethnic slurs.* It is alleged that when referring to the appearance of patrol cars, Collazo said, "I'm not going to live here like a nigger" or "We're not going to live like a bunch of niggers".
- *That Collazo used his position to secure special privileges for others.* It is alleged that Collazo routinely ordered Jim Boeck to have staff at the Seguin Municipal Court "dismiss" parking tickets, traffic tickets, and other citations. It is further alleged that Collazo showed special treatment to Christina M. Luna by repeatedly ordering that Ms. Luna's parking tickets be "voided".

As these affidavits become available, I will fax them to you as quickly as possible. As I mentioned on the phone, I want to ensure that you and your client have adequate time to review the allegations and prepare for the pre-disciplinary hearing. I look forward to meeting you Monday, and to discussing the other issues raised in your letter, including the hearing date, the number of witnesses, and the time allotted for the hearing.
